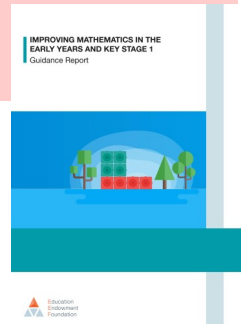


# Miss Thompson's Tips For Metacognition

- Plan staff training based around recommendation 3.

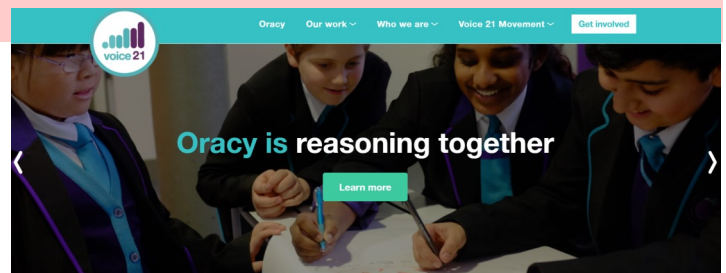
