The programme, which is co-designed and delivered by Doncaster Research School and Doncaster LA, will utilise the skills and expertise of writing experts as well as school practitioners and aims to:

- share the most recent and relevant research evidence which will enable schools to consider effective strategies to close gaps in attainment in writing, particularly for disadvantaged pupils, post COVID and beyond;
- enable schools to improve the teaching of writing and explore a range of effective writing interventions;
- give schools access to a toolkit of resources;
- share best practice from those schools who have been successful in closing gaps for disadvantaged pupils in writing.

The programme consists of:

- an initial virtual launch event on 12th May 2021;
- 5 further extended twilights, delivered virtually across the Summer term 2021;
- access to expert speakers;
- a toolkit of resources for improving outcomes in writing, including diagnostic tools and other practical resources.

2 delegates (maximum) per school are invited to attend each session, this should include the Literacy Lead/Senior Leader with responsibility for writing in the school.
