An introduction to the latest EEF guidance report
Wednesday 6th October 8am – 9am

Released in June 2021 this guidance report looks at 6 key principles of good feedback rather than the most effective method of delivery. It focuses on principles, methods and implementation and can provide the foundations for whole school or departmental feedback.

The Teaching & Learning Toolkit

On 17th September the EEF will launch significant updates to the teaching & learning toolkit.
