UNITE

Unite people around what is being implemented, how it will be implemented, and why it matters.



REFLECT

Reflect, monitor, and adapt to improve implementation.

Join John Marsh for a practical, grounded exploration of what it really takes to implement oracy successfully across a school. Rooted in the Education Endowment Foundation's *A School's Guide to Implementation*, this session focuses on the behaviours that make change stick. Using the lens of Engage, Unite, Reflect, John will explore how schools can build genuine staff buy-in, align practice and refine their approach over time rather than launching short-lived initiatives. This session will bring to life how a robust, whole-school oracy curriculum can be introduced and sustained — not as an add-on but as something embedded across teaching, learning and classroom culture.
